We are pleased to now offer mobile VR units for rent. Please familiarize yourself with the information below to determine if a mobile rental may be for you.

What you get

- VR setup (VR headset and controllers) play it as much as you want!
- Large selection of games which we continue to update (see below)
- High-capacity external headset battery which can be attached for extended play
- Two spare AA batteries (for the controllers)

What you need

- Reliable high-speed internet connection
- Reliable wireless router with an accessible wireless network
- A safe clear floor space of approximately 10 feet by 10 feet (it doesn't have to be that specific, you teach the headset the boundaries in the initial setup, it's like drawing on the floor!)
- Optionally (but highly recommended) a TV with spare HDMI input to display headset video.

Pricing

1 system - 4 days: \$160 + tax 2 systems – 4 days: \$260 + tax

Pickup/Dropoff

Pickup and drop-off is to be arranged by call/text to 902-213-6580. The current pickup/dropoff location is 992 Rustico Rd (in front of garage, please call/text when arriving). This location is approximately 6-7 minutes from the Winsloe Irving.

Payment is required at time of pickup. You will need to sign a short, common-sense, rental agreement.

Your headset will be checked by a member of the Ultimate VR team following its return. If any issues/damage are noted you will be made aware and charged accordingly (up to full replacement value). All headsets are tested and fully functional prior to rental.

Support

We are unable to offer support for the mobile setups. The basic setup is relatively straight-forward but you need to be aware that we are not on call for technical support issues or to help with the games. As long as you know how to change your TV to another input and connect a device to a wireless network you should be good to go. Please note that most hotel guest wifi systems will not allow the headset to stream to the Chromecast for viewing on a TV. Don't be afraid to use Google or Youtube for help! We'll provide a quick-start sheet with all of the info you should need.

We recommend you take some time to familiarize yourself with the setup prior to hosting a few friends or family members for a gaming session. It takes the stress out of performing a last-minute setup and makes the experience more enjoyable for everyone. If you're ok with these last two paragraphs – a mobile VR setup is likely for you!
